EXHIBIT "A"

AUBURN LAKES POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Pool access cards are required for entry into the facility.
- No diving.
- No running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, splashing, or aggressive play.
- No balls (except soft, nerf type balls), frisbees, squirt guns, or projectile based toys are allowed.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs allowed.
- No glass in the pool or park area.
- No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- No denim or street clothes are allowed in the pool.
- No large floats or boats allowed.
- Only US Coast Guard approved floatation devices are allowed. Supervising adult must be within arm's reach of the child wearing the floatation device.
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult of legal age.

- Lifeguards are the ultimate authority in all pool related matters.
- Lifeguards have the right to excuse an individual or group from the pool.
- Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, or overcrowding at the discretion of management.
- Individuals will be held responsible for the actions of their guests.
- Individuals with a communicable disease are requested to not enter the pool facility for at least two weeks.
- All non-toilet trained babies must wear swim diapers.
- All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and bare sole responsibility.
- Management will not be held responsible for loss or damage of personal property.
