MINUTES OF PARKS AND RECREATION MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

January 23, 2019

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THE STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF HARRIS OAKMONT PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Oakmont Public Utility District (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, at Auburn Lakes Recreation Center, the District's designated meeting place inside the boundaries of the District, on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.; whereupon, the roll was called of the members of the Board, to-wit:

All members of the Board were present, thus constituting a quorum.

Also in attendance were those who provided their names on the sign-in sheet attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Additionally, in attendance were: Tina DeAses, The Risher Companies, the District's Recreation Manager ("Risher"); Mel Reist of Silversands Services, the District's landscape maintenance vendor; Tom Dillard of Champions-Hydrolawn; and Michael Murr, the District's Landscape Architect.

WHEREUPON, the meeting was called to order in accordance with the posted meeting notice, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

APPROVE MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 28, 2018

The Board considered the minutes of the meeting held November 28, 2018 which were distributed to the Board for review prior to the meeting. After discussion, upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes as presented.

RATIFY SECOND AMENDMENT TO GARBAGE CONTRACT

This item was deferred.

RECREATION CENTER MANAGER REPORT

The Board recognized Ms. DeAses, who presented the Recreation Center Manager's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "C."

Ms. DeAses then presented a proposal from Silversand Services for a function cost increase to the annual services contract from \$43,065 to \$45,943. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

A proposal was then presented for the installation of one truck load of crushed granite gravel at the walking trail along the East Pond at a cost of \$2,650. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

The Board then considered authorizing Silversand Services to add a coupler near the water line inside the pool premises for a cost of \$300. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

Ms. DeAses then presented a proposal from Silversand Services for the removal of one tree at the recreation center that poses a hazard for a cost of \$800. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

A proposal was then presented for the filling of the gaps along the retaining wall at the West Pond at a cost of \$200. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

The Board then considered authorizing Aquatics Management to install a second sanitation line at the splash pad at a cost of \$2,444. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

Ms. Deases also presented a proposals from several companies to change the sand filters at the pool. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal from DS Recreational Services at a cost of \$2,400.

The Board then considered a proposal from Natural Concepts for the installation of uplighting of the trees at the recreation center, a project totaling \$3,100. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal as presented.

After discussion and review, upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Recreation Center Manager's Report as presented. However, no other action items were acted upon.

HEAR FROM SILVERSAND SERVICES

The Silversand Services report was presented above.

LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT REPORT

The Board then recognized Mr. Murr, who presented the Landscape Architect's Report in, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

After review of the report and discussion, upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Landscape Architect's Report, including authorization for the Landscape Architect to (i) pursue quotes for the installation of benches at the West Pond, (ii) proceed with installation of 80 trees at the East Pond at a cost of \$3,600, and (iii) investigate the relocation of a tree along West Rayford Road.

HEAR FROM CHAMPIONS HYDRO-LAWN

The Board recognized Mr. Dillard. A formal report was not presented. No action was taken.

HEAR FROM RECREATION COMMITTEE

The Board recognized the Recreation Committee. The Board considered approving a meeting date of the Auburn Lakes Homeowner's Association to be held February 21st. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to approve the meeting.

HEAR FROM THE PUBLIC

The Board then opened the floor to receive comments from the public. No comments were presented.

There being no other business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.







Mike,

The 4 best trees are all 11" in diameter. I would recommend pre-hydration and root pruning as much in advance of the transplanting as possible. Trees this size supplied and installed with the 120" spade are around \$10,000 each. If we have access for the trailer mounted 125" spade we can move them for \$4,150 each and they will do great. I'm attaching a photo of the big 125" spade for you reference. If we root prune them at 98", let them sit as long as possible and use the 100" spade to move them I would only expect a 50% survival rate compared to 95%. Moved with the 100" would be \$1750 each. Root pruning by hand making clean cuts is included in both prices. Both scenarios will require good post maintenance of course.
